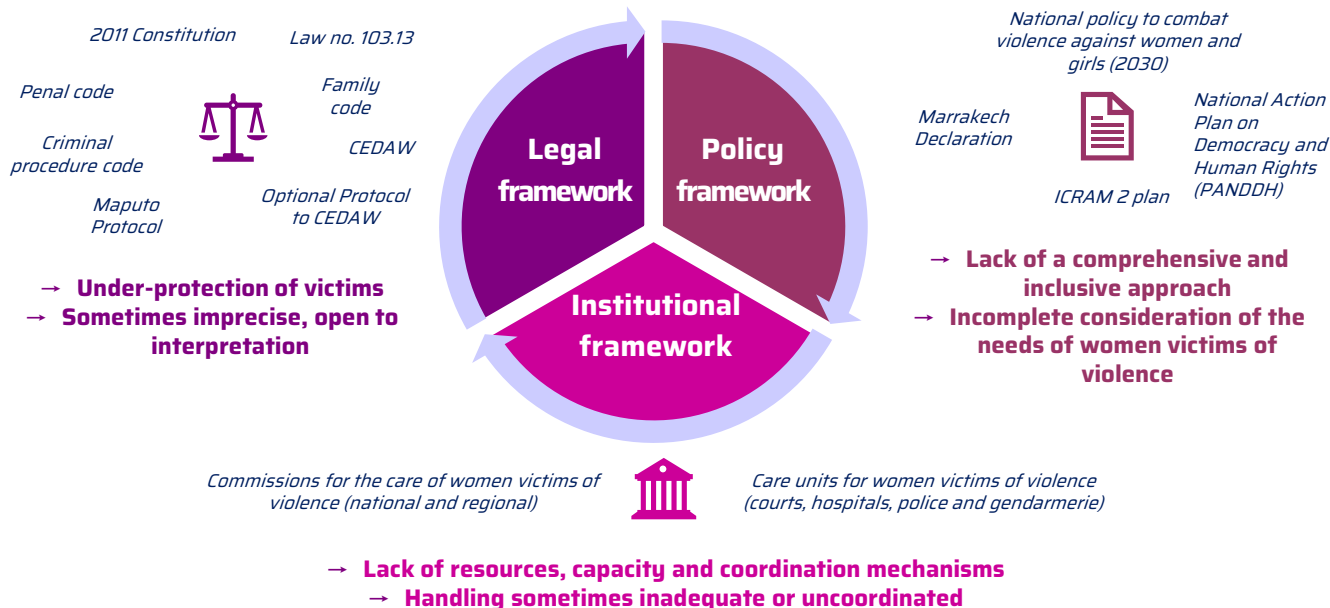

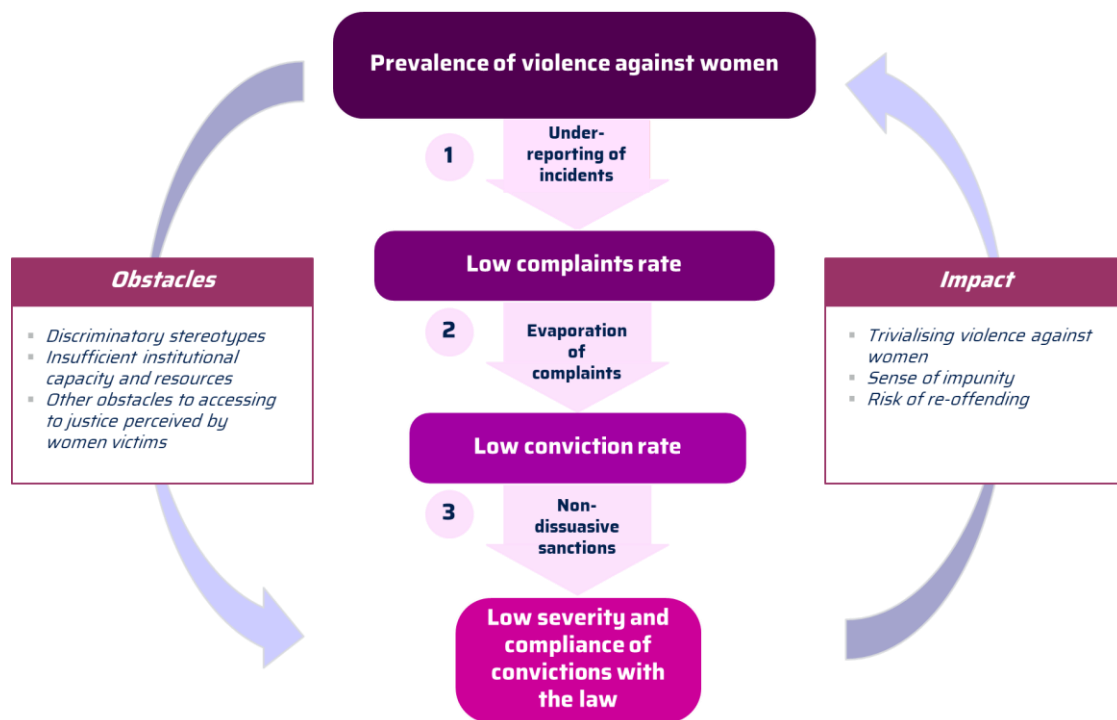

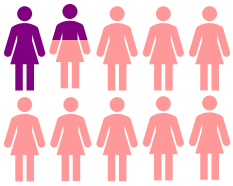

1 THE *UNDER-REPORTING* OF VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN INCIDENTS

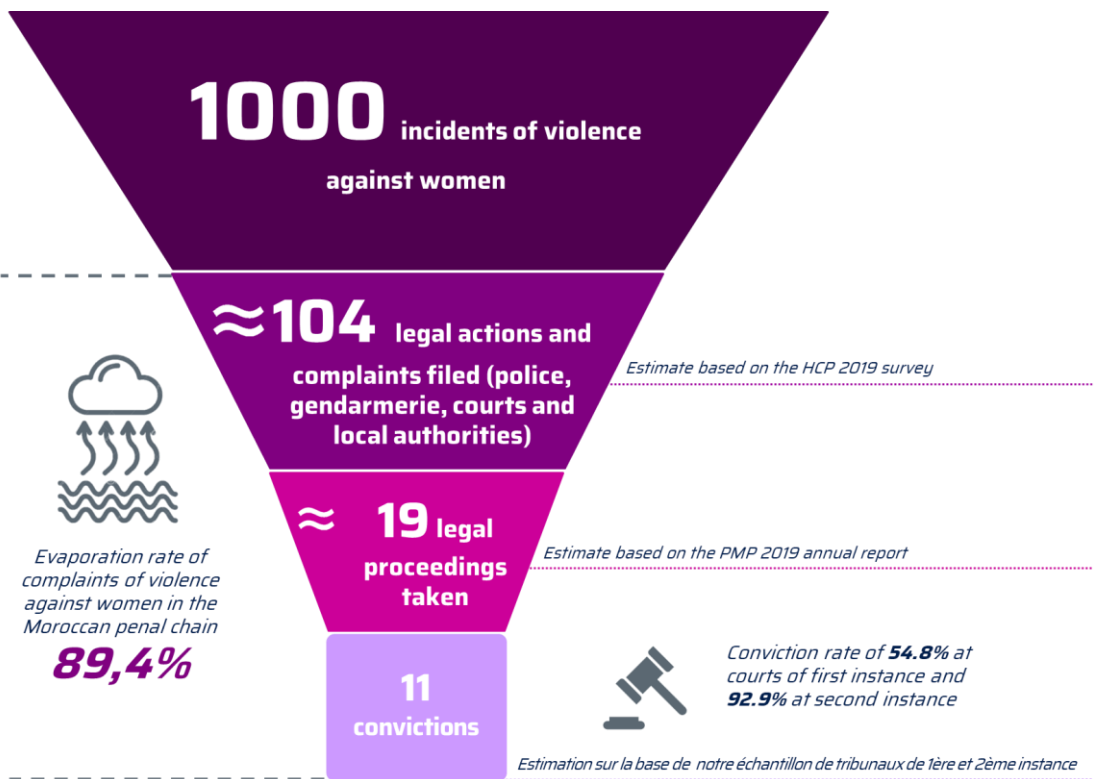

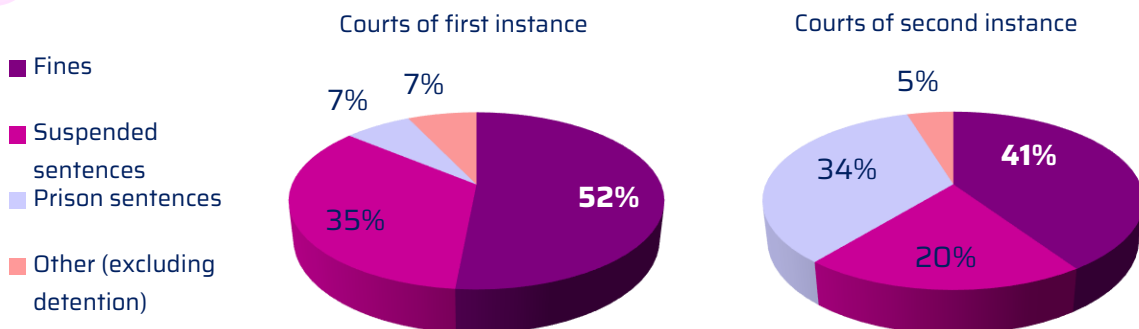
